

Recycling Sites in Summit County

Offering on-site recycling is cost prohibitive, but here are some local options.

Silverthorne Drop-off – in between 3rd and 4th on Brian, M-F, 8:4:30

Frisco Drop-off Center – County Commons, across from Animal Shelter

Breckenridge Drop-off Center – County Road 450, ¼ mile on left

Dillon Mobile Drop-off Trailer – Dillon Town Hall parking lot



Here are basic guidelines for recycling. Each site may vary slightly.

MIXED PAPER	Newspapers & Inserts; Magazines; White & Light Colored Office Paper; Envelopes; Notebook Paper <i>Staples, paper clips; tape are OK</i>	Neon Colored Paper; Tissues; Napkins; Paper Plates or Cups; Phone Books
MIXED PLASTICS	#1, #2, #4, #5, #7 Plastics Bottles	#3 PVC; #6 Polystyrene; Styrofoam; Motor Oil Containers;
MIXED METAL CONTAINERS	Aluminum Cans; Aluminum Foil & Pie Plates; Tin Cans	Scrap Metal
CARDBOARD & PAPERBOARD	Flattened Cardboard; Brown Paper Bags; Paperboard; <i>Staples and tape are OK</i>	Milk or Soy Milk Cartons; Wax-Coated Cardboard; Other Paper
MIXED GLASS	Bottles & Jars; Clear, Yellow, Green, Blue Colors	Window Glass; Drinking Glasses; Pyrex; Ceramic Dishes
BROWN GLASS	Bottles & Jars	Window Glass; Drinking Glasses; Pyrex; Ceramic Dishes

Recycling Plastic Shopping Bags

Bags should not be placed in recycling containers because it contaminates the items, but bags can be recycled at City Market, Safeway and **Wal-Mart**.
